Honoring September Suicide Prevention Month

Many of us find it hurtful when it's implied that we could have done something to have prevented our children's death.

I want to acknowledge something that often gets left out when people talk about suicide "prevention." For those living with chronic, relapsing psychiatric illness, the standard interventions—safety plans, hotlines, even hospitalizations—often don't change the long-term outcome.

There's no solid evidence that these tools reduce suicide in this specific group. Much of the published data focuses on people in acute, impulsive crises, where an interruption can make a difference, or are follow up studies after those who attempt suicide and come to the ER. But here's the truth. When someone has lived for years with relentless suicidality, they often learn how to "job the system"—saying whatever they need to say to avoid hospitalization or to appease therapists and loved ones. That doesn't mean they're manipulative; it means they've adapted to survive in a system that doesn't actually treat the other underlying illness.

So while public health experts need broad terms like "prevention," those of us who have lived it know that word can feel offensive or hollow. It implies that if only we—or our children—had used the tools correctly, the outcome would have been different. The reality is more complicated. Interventions may help the majority who are in momentary crisis, but they don't necessarily change the trajectory for people with chronic, treatment-resistant illness. My heart goes out with love to all of you who have lost. This month is to remember and celebrate the lives of our children. And for those who struggle to stay. Anonymous Parent


